# HIGHLIGHTS OF 2022-23

# LIVELIHOOD - WOMEN HEALTH ENTREPRENURSHIP PROGRAM:

MAYA initiated women Health Entrepreneurship program to promote preventive healthcare and enable well-being ensuring sustained good health by creating dedicated, trained, technology enabled health entrepreneurs (HEs)also called as Health Navigators who provide health services like basic screening, BP, Blood Sugar and Anaemia tests to the community at their door steps. MAYA's approach is to make these Health Navigators self-sustain and continue screening and following up community with essential health service and products at affordable rate to improve their health.

This program piloted at Channapatna with 15 Health Navigators on board later extended to 5 talukas of Ramanagara and Maddur districts of Karnataka.

#### In 2022-23:

**88 Women Health Entrepreneurs** (HEs) provided Blood pressure, Blood sugar and Anaemia services to the community covering 5 talukas of 2 districts Channapatna, Kanakpura, Ramanagara of Ramanagara District and Maddur, Malavalli of Mandya Districts. No. of BP screenings: 28,679 No. of sugar screenings: 31,115 and No. of HB screenings conducted from July 2022 to March 2023.

# **Certification to the HEs:**

In order to get the recognition and acceptance within the community the Heath Entrepreneurs went through training and certification process and was certified by MAYA and Bangalore Baptist Hospital on 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022

#### **HEs Service to the Artisans:**

Besides providing service to the community HEs entered into an agreement with Artisanpride Producer Company to screen the artisans and their family.

# Data in google forms:

To streamline HEs service information, google forms was created. HEs are entering the collected data of their service given to the community in to these forms. After analyzing the entered forms MAYA is encouraging the HEs by recognizing their performance by giving gift to them.

# **Channapatna Community Health Library:**

An Infrastructure was set up at Channapatna to Enhance Community Health, Wellbeing & Livelihoods through Participatory Design & Deployment. This project is funded by APC-Locnet community network grant scheme. The infrastructure using low cost open source and locally configurable components supported HEs work. A mesh node was placed in few places of Channapatna connecting to the local server which helped the community such as ASHA workers, anganwadi teachers and housholds to engage with the knowledge created to learn and solve health related problems. Health Library currently has about 200 audio-video items (in the local languages of Kannada) of local health and wellbeing. The HNs engage in collating and curating the library, as well as to enable health knowledge exchange between their communities and local public health to educate and activate them with information that is locally rooted and relevant.

Successful Story of a Health Entrepreneur:



Sowmya

I am 32 years old, completed MA B Ed, was working as a part time teacher, but stopped working after my second child. I was attending tailoring classes when MAYA field coordinator explained about the opportunity to work as Health Entrepreneur. I came for the orientation and found it interesting. Earlier I was hoping of getting a job as a teacher in a govt school but I had to pay for the post which I could not afford. After becoming Health Entrepreneur I reach 250+ clients in a month with an average monthly income is Rs. 5000+. I have two children aged 7 and 4½ years. My younger daughter has health problem and had to undergo throat surgery and with the income earned as HE I could pay hospital bills and also I am able to buy TV, Fridge on instalment basis. My husband works in a factory nearby for low salary.

#### **LIVELIHOOD - ARTISANPRIDE:**

MAYA supported formation of Artisanpride Producer Company Limited (Producer company) and Fairkraft Creations Pvt Ltd (Marketing company) to benefit the lacware artisans of Channapatna by way of providing income through business opportunities.

MAYA was able get fund from MSME-SFURTI scheme to increase the livelihood of the artisans by providing infrastructure and technology for better productivity. A common Facility Centre (CFC) was constructed, new machineries were installed.

Installed 25KWp Roof top Solar Grid-Tie system on roof top of the CFC and the power generated from Solar are supplied to the grid





# **Purchase of New Machineries**

In 2022-23 below new machineries were purchased from the MSME-SFURTI fund which helping in reducing the time and drudgery of the artisans in the process of making toys and other accessories:

- Krutz Dust Collector 3 HP Double bag with hosepipe
- Vacuum Sealing Machine with Nitrogen Flush Facility
- Shrink Wrapping machine
- Table Top Dewalt portable planer
- Continuous Band Sealer for Nitrogen Packing
- Air Curtain
- CNC Router Stepper Motor

#### Copy Turning Lathe:

One of the important machine is used to make semi-finished products and artisans to do the final. Which helps the artisans to increase their productivity and save time the emphasis to utilize artisans skill and reduce mechanical work.



# Implementation of Lean Management:

To improve production and to reduce waste Lean Management was implemented throughout all functions at CFC.

MAYA also was able to get funds from **NABARD** for formation and nurturing of intensive Major Off-farm Producer Organization(OFPO), through which identified 10 small local manufacturing units in various artisan clusters called Spokes. These Spokes have standard lathes and other required tools which are close to the artisan's houses, a clean and safe working environment specially for women artisans.

#### In 2022-23:

- Artisan Basic and Technical training provided for 25 women who are from Beedi rolling sector.
- 250 members paid full share capital
- 190 artisans are covered under Insurance by Lakshya Organization (Aditya Birla Marketing Partner) where they are provided Hospital Cash Benefit
- 9 Spokes out of 10 are functioning
- Participated in Delhi Haat Exhibition(SFURTI Mela a national level exhibition for 15 days at New Delhi), Daskar, India GI Fair, G20, Mahalakshmi Saras and VTPC exhibition.
- Buyer Sellar Meet held at Channapatna CFC on 10th Oct 2022 to





#### Successful stories of the Artisans:



**Kubra Bano** 

I am 30 years old and unmarried living in Indira Cottage, Channapatna, Ramanagara District, Karnataka. I am the only earning member of the family as my father is not earning. I am taking care of my old parents and younger sister who is a widow and diabetic who is rolling beedi at home and earning minimum income.

Since 2019 I am working in toy assembly group of Artisanpride Producer Company Ltd. I am assembling types of toys like peppy-five, tutu turtle, cubby, Ma Me Pa etc and few office and home décor products.

Before joining, our family had financial crisis where we could not fulfil basic needs of the family. I was part of MAYA learning centre where I received basic education.

I attended an education visit to Janapadaloka to get training about ecommerce.

I am 40 years old and unmarried living in Ramanagara town, Ramanagara District Karnataka. I have a brother and 2 sisters. I have the responsibility of my old father, younger sister and a brother. My brother is dumb and deaf working as housekeeping in Artisan pride office at Channapatna Craft Park. One of my sisters is married and another sister is not working.

I am currently working in Quality checking group of Artisanpride Producer Company Ltd. I do product quality inspection, safety compliance using gauges as per the safety norms, check individual components and approve the good quality products and reject the bad quality products.

I had an exposure visit to TITAN factory recently to know the manufacturing process. There were 33 artisans visited TITAN and learnt the process flow, quality control, housekeeping standards etc.

#### **PROTECTION OF YOUTH:**

# **Celebrating Life Addiction Free (CLAF):**

MAYA initiated Celebrating Life Addiction Free (CLAF) along with Karnataka NO for Tobacco (KNOT) alliance towards protecting youth from the harms of tobacco during 22-23.

# Key achievements of CLAF:

- Trained more than 1000 students on harms of tobacco and their roles in tobacco control measures.
- MAYA signed an MOU with Dayanand Sagar University towards supporting the institution on tobacco control activities. 4 More institutions are being approached.
- MAYA hosted an artwork competition for the students which fetched more than 35 artworks on tobacco control that are being shared with the Govt and on social media posts.
- Developed audio visual IEC materials and training modules on engaging the youth on tobacco control. This has been appreciated by other states and are replicating the same.

# Other Key Highlights:

- Supported BBMP in capacity building and sensitization of enforcement officials like Police, Health Inspectors, Teachers, anganwadi workers etc.
- MAYA supported the Govt with the draft implementation guidelines for the Vendor Licensing.
- A butts collection campaign was conducted to highlight the violations of COTPA and the health issues caused 400 students were engaged in the activities from 5 colleges.
- Sensitized 8 MPs on the need for strengthening tobacco control policies and secured support from 4 MPs.







# **Tobacco Free Education Institution Program**

MAYA received grant from Narotam Seksharia Foundation (NSF) for making schools Tobacco free in Ramanagara District of Karnataka.

As per the objectives of the project master training at taluk level to 35 teachers, block level teachers training for 315 teachers was given, also sensitized State Director, DDPI, BEO's and BRC at the district level.

In 2022 organized Tobacco Awareness seminar on World No Tobacco Day combined with world environment Day in collaboration with Education and Health Department. Also oriented children to pledge freedom from Tobacco in view if Independence Day. Introduced online monitoring to assess the compliance of status of schools to Tobacco Free guidelines. Few children provided short videos message to policy makers. Two villages declared tobacco free village.










